All employees are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct which sets clear expectations about ethical behavior and compliance with laws. Pentair conducts annual Code of Conduct training and provides multiple ways for employees to ask for help and report misconduct and illegal or unethical behavior including via published helplines and an intake tool available at www.pentairethics.com. We are committed to investigating and responding to all concerns.

Pentair's suppliers are expected to adhere to our Supplier Code of Conduct which prohibits forced labor, child labor and discrimination. It also presoper attentional problems applicable laws regarding human trafficking and slavery. Pentair

audits and assesses many of its suppliers annually and maintains the right to audit its suppliers with respect to any potential non conformance with the Supplier Code of Conduct.
